Research Statement

My research uses an “eight perspectives” interdisciplinary framework to study love, bonds, and attachments. I use approaches from ethology, ecology, psychology, and behavioural science. I am currently focusing on five research priorities: the psychology of maternal and romantic love, the evolution of romantic love, love and health, families, and improving the science of love. I value collaboration. I hope to translate my findings into solutions for real-world challenges like the declining fertility rate, societal functioning, and health. The impact of my research has been recognised with invitations to present at a Royal Society Meeting in 2026 and lead a target article for the journal *Evolution and Human Behavior*.
